Drawing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use line to create shapes, patterns and textures</li> <li>• Draw from observation</li> <li>• Hold and control a variety of media to make marks and lines</li> <li>• Draw using a range of surfaces and scales</li> <li>• Use drawing to develop and share ideas</li> </ul>
Painting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Name, choose and match primary and secondary colours</li> <li>• Paint using a range of surfaces and scales</li> <li>• Paint from observation and to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination</li> <li>• Use art specific language related to colour and shape when discussing their own work and work of artists</li> </ul>
Printing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Load an object with paint and print it – experiment with a range of methods</li> <li>• Make rubbings from textured surfaces</li> <li>• Recognise and experiment with regular/irregular/symmetrical print patterns</li> <li>• Work on a range of surfaces and scales</li> </ul>
Sculpture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mould and create simple shapes with malleable materials</li> <li>• Combine found materials to create junk models</li> <li>• Use simple tools to cut and shape a range of materials</li> <li>• Develop the language to describe the structures created</li> <li>• Sculpt to develop and share ideas, experiences and imaginations</li> </ul>
Collage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use scissors safely to cut a range of materials – cut straight lines</li> <li>• Tear paper into strips and simple shapes</li> <li>• Apply adhesive correctly and place surfaces together accurately</li> <li>• Classify materials into textures and colours</li> </ul>
ICT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experiment with an art package, trying different tools and effects to make pictures</li> <li>• Begin to use digital cameras to record own work</li> <li>• Use online art activities to create repeating patterns</li> <li>• Explore mark making on the interactive whiteboard</li> </ul>
Textiles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Handle and manipulate a wide range of fabrics and threads</li> <li>• Understand that fabrics come in a range of weights, patterns, textures etc and have different uses</li> <li>• Use scissors to cut fabric and thread</li> <li>• Thread beads onto lace/string/wool</li> </ul>
General Points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explore a range of techniques and approaches gaining confidence in ability – maintaining a piece of art work to a satisfying conclusion</li> <li>• Experiment with ideas and remain flexible in approach and outcome</li> <li>• Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products</li> <li>• Develop techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space</li> </ul>
