Our Music curriculum at Petersgate aims to engage and inspire our children and to develop their love and appreciation of music.

In Years 1 and 2 (Key Stage 1) the children learn to:

use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes

play tuned and untuned instruments musically

listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music

experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the eight inter-related dimensions of music including pitch, tempo and dynamics

In Early Years, our Music learning is covered in our 'Expressive Arts and Design' area of learning where the children learn to:

sing songs, make music and dance, and experiment with ways of changing them

represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings throug design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories

Listen to Me

We are very lucky to have to have Mr. Hoskins from Hampshire Music Service (HMS) come into school once a week to deliver 'Listen to Me' sessions, which is very kindly funded by PoPS. Currently, he is teaching in Year 2, giving the children the amazing opportunity of learning to play ukulele. During the second half of the year, he will be teaching African drumming to Year 1 where the children will experience playing an exciting range of drums and explore playing different rhythms.
