Mathematics at Petersgate

During the spring term and into summer we have been exploring lots of mathematics.

Early Years have been exploring sharing between 2 and 3 as part of their new Gingerbread Man topic.





The children created their own game with the gingerbread people and the buttons. They took it in turns to roll the dice matching number of buttons to the gingerbread people by counting on to keep a running total. The first person to get 20 buttons was the winner!



Finding different ways of making the same number on a 10s frame.

Year 1 have been investigating capacity, they had great fun in the water tray filling their containers with water to show full, nearly full, half-full or half empty, nearly empty and empty. They also solved practical problems estimating how many cups of water would be needed to fill a container or which container would hold the most.








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Using directional language, the children followed each other's instructions to walk a path. To challenge themselves further, they wore a blindfold listening carefully to very clear directions.

They have been collecting data about animals and then representing the data in different forms such as: in a block graph, bar graph and pie chart.


