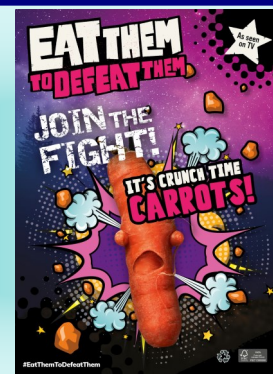

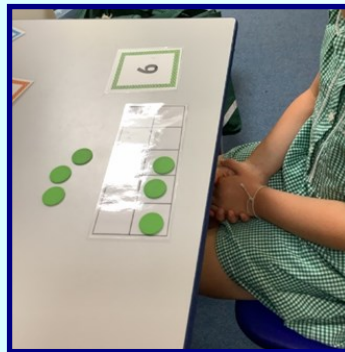

Mathematics at Petersgate

We have been very busy mathematicians this term using our existing knowledge to help us problem solve.



Early Years have been looking at doubling, halving and combining. They have been using objects to double amounts and numbers to 10. When halving, the children made sure that both amounts were the same and understood. Some of us could see a pattern with these amounts and we used the language of 'odd and even'.

When combining we used figures to problem solve, including how many legs 2, 3 or 4 children would have and looked for patterns in the numbers.

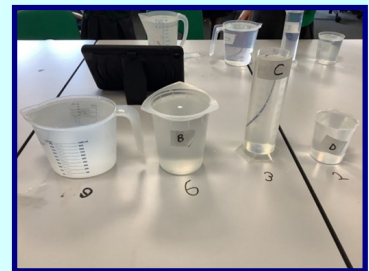
During Science Week, Year 1 investigated what trees grow in the school grounds. They had to look very carefully at the shape and pattern of the leaves to identify the trees. They also found the widest and narrowest tree by measuring the circumference of the trunk.



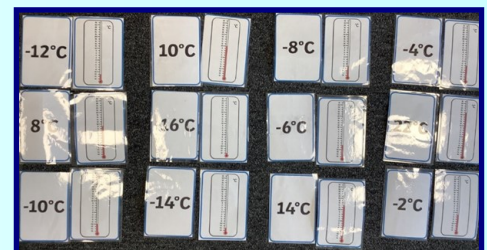
Year 2 have been problem solving with measure

Measuring accurately volume and capacity, practising our maths vocabulary and using the correct scale based on volume - ml, ltrs.

Get ready for **Wild World Heroes**, arriving online and in your local library this summer, starting **3rd July until 18th**

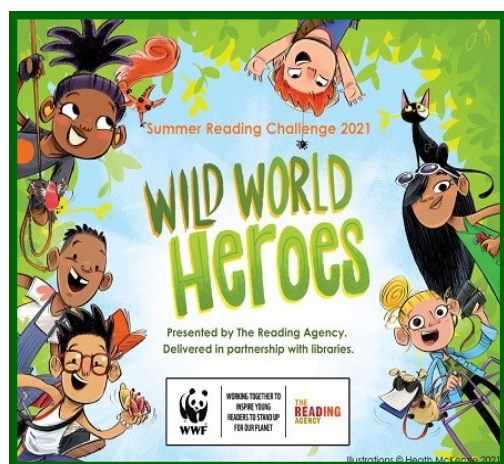
September. There will be plenty of activities, puzzles and online book reviews to keep you entertained this summer.

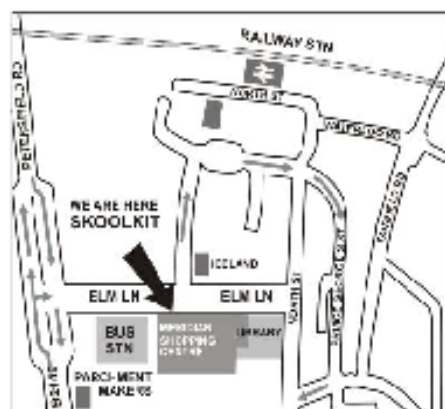
